2 | Choose a method to save your images:

**Option 1:** Right click on the images and save them to a sharable online folder (Google Photos, OneDrive, iCloud, Drop Box, Pinterest, etc.). Name them with a short description of what you like in the image. Share this folder with RFRA.

Examples: "Wall Colors", "Lamp next to sofa", "Window Treatments", "Overall Room Layout"

**Option 2:** Open a Word document. Take screenshots of the images and paste them in the document. Add descriptions by or under each photo identifying the elements you like. Email this document to RFRA.

**Option 3:** Save the images to a folder local to your computer and name them as described in option 1. Email them to RFRA.
